UFSC ICE SHOW RULES

Ice show rules are included in the "Standing Rules" of the Utah FSC, which are posted on the Club bulletin board, web-site and are included in the Club Directory. All members are encouraged to read these rules.

Eligibility for Participation: To participate in the Show, a skater must:

- Be a member of either the UFSC or the SDRC Learn-to-Skate program.
- Submit application and fees by the Due date. ***Payment is non-refundable.***
- Applications received after the deadline in January shall incur a late fee determined by the Show Director.
- Full Home-Club members will receive four (4) ice show tickets at no additional cost. Skaters are encouraged to sell ice show tickets. The Show committee may set incentives for ticket sales by Show participants.
- Skaters must purchase their own costumes. The Show Committee will make reasonable attempts to keep the costs of costumes affordable.
- Skaters must be current on all bills to UFSC, SDRC, and professionals.
- Skaters must arrange to attend all **MANDATORY** show practices and rehearsals.
- Skaters or immediate family members must volunteer for at least one show job.
- Skaters will be allowed to skate in only one show number, plus the opening & finale, except for Special Olympics coaches or otherwise at the Show Director's discretion.
- Soloists and Special Olympians & their student coaches must supply their own costume (therefore, they do not pay the costume fee).
- Supporting Home-Club members who would like to be eligible for a Solo/Step out & four (4) ice show tickets (include the value of the tickets) must pay the **\$35.00 up-grade fee by Thursday, March 11, 2010.**
- Soloists are responsible for selecting & editing their music, but music selections must be approved by the ice show director. Be sure to list the program length limit (historically, not to exceed 2:10 for Junior & Senior).
- There will be an additional performance on Thursday night. Jozef is unavailable to perform on Saturday night this year.
- Costume fees are included in the registration fee. The initial costume fitting/meeting will be the Thursday following the application due date from 4:30 p.m. - 6:45 p.m. & this meeting is **MANDATORY.**
