- **Solos: Skaters at and above Juvenile level will have solos in the ice show. Soloists must have tested and passed Juvenile Freeskate Test level by application deadline (January 6, 2012).**
- **Group numbers will be assigned by test level as of the application deadline (January 6, 2012).**
- **This year's ice show fee will be \$65 for non-soloists and \$50 for soloists.**

Other Important Information:

- All skaters must be members of UFSC and current in their fees to SDRC, UFSC, and pros.
- Qualified Members* who skate in the ice show will receive 4 free tickets to the show.
- Qualified Member* skaters who have passed the Juvenile, Intermediate, Novice, Junior or Senior Freestyle Test will be (1) given a solo as assigned by the director; and, (2) given one or more group numbers; and, (3) be required to skate in both the opening and closing numbers.
- Qualified Member* skaters who have passed the pre-preliminary, preliminary, pre-juvenile Freestyle Test will be (1) given a step-out as assigned by the director; and, (2) given one or more group numbers; and, (3) be required to skate in both the opening and closing numbers.
- Non-soloists will skate in (1) one or more group numbers; and, (2) both the opening and closing numbers.
- All soloists will be expected to perform numbers in accordance with the theme of the ice show. Solo music will be assigned at the direction of the ice show director.
- The length of all solos and step-outs will be subject to the ice show director's discretion.
- Soloists will be responsible for their own costumes and all other skaters will be charged a costume rental fee. Group costumes will be returned after the last performance of the show and will be maintained as property of UFSC. Skaters will, however, be given the opportunity to purchase their group costume for the full cost of the costume after the last performance of the show.
- Skaters must arrange to attend all show practices and rehearsals. Excused absences due to extenuating circumstances will only be accepted if arrangements with the ice show director have been made in advance of the absence(s).
