The Intermountain Interclub Association, a member of US Figure Skating has combined their efforts with Utah Hockey to coordinate information that will be happening at the different venues during the 10-day celebration beginning with the relighting of the Olympic Cauldron at Rice-Eccles Stadium of February 8th.

Events:

February 2-4 - Winter Games Figure Skating Competition

Skaters from all across the state of Utah compete for a chance to participate in Skate America in 2013. From Beginners to the more advanced skaters all are welcome to come and showcase, freestyle and dance their way to a gold medal. This 3-day event is free to watch and is held at the County Ice Center in Murray.

February 11 - Free Skate Session and Meet and Greet

Come skate, get your photo taken and visit with several athletes training here in Utah including Champions from the 2002 Games and upcoming future champions. The event will occur at the Park City Ice Arena from 2:00-4:00 p.m.

February 11 - Cast Reunion

Cottonwood Heights Recreation Center will host a 10 year Cast Reunion at the rink from 1:00-2:00 p.m. They are hosting a free exhibition, including solos skating to Olympic music from the Opening and Closing Ceremonies. We are also having a group number of original "Children of Light". After, we will have a 2:00-4:00 p.m. public session at a discounted rate. We have invited the public to come wearing clothing that represents the Olympics and to bring memorabilia to showcase.

February 16 - "Rekindle the Fire Within"

The South Davis Recreation Center will be host to Olympic Champion, Jozef Sabovcik and other athletes who will "Rekindle the Fire Within" as they have a meet and greet for the community complete with champions, past and present, skating and performing to music from the Olympic Ceremonies. The Children of Light will also be featured with our new synchronized skating team. The event will take place from 6:00-8:00 p.m.

February 17 - Welcome the World

The community of Kearns " Welcomes the World" once again! Relive the Winter Olympics with a live Parade of Nations, a Children of Light figure skating performance, sport exhibitions, a torch re-lighting with past and present speed skating athletes, autographs and photos with athletes, and 2002 Olympic memorabilia. The event will take place at the Olympic Oval from 5:00-9:00 p.m.

February 17 - Snowshoe Fun Run

Ogden Ice Sheet is hosting a snowshoe 5K fun run across the Weber State campus beginning at 6:00 p.m. and concluding at the Ogden Ice Sheet where a 7:05 p.m. ceremony will honor Olympic Volunteers. At 7:30 p.m. the Ogden Mustangs will play a hockey game and between periods, the Ogden Curling Club will demonstrate curling. Olympic memorabilia also will be on display. The snowshoe run costs \$20.02 and you can buy hockey tickets for \$2.02.

March 15-17 - US Figure Skating Adult Sectional Competition

Utah keeps the Olympic legacy alive by hosting two national championships in March. The Peaks Ice Arena in Provo hosts the US Figure Skating Adults Sectional Competition.

March 21-25 - National High School Hockey Championships

The best high school hockey players in the country come to Utah to compete in the National High School Hockey Championship that will be held in Salt Lake County
